Dear Parents,

The end of term offers an opportunity to reflect on what has been achieved over the last four months by our wonderful Haverstock students and staff. Despite the challenges of the school closure, our students attended and participated in over 90% of their online lessons. They have returned to school and supported the sometimes tiresome 'Covid secure' measures with good grace and the school has been as calm and focused as I have seen it since we returned on 8th March. Thank you for your support this term, a time in which parents' role in their children's education has never been greater.

Below are a few important messages and reminders for the end of term and return to school.

Dates:

- The last day of term is **Wednesday 31st March**. The day is a full timetabled day for all year groups - so students will leave at the usual time in the afternoon.
- The first day of term is **Monday 19th April**. Students should arrive at the normal time in the morning.
- **Monday June 7th** is our final INSET day of the year. No students will be at school on this day.

Track and Trace during the holiday.

If your child tests positive for COVID 19 during the holiday period, you must let us know via office@haverstock.camden.sch.uk. Please note the telephone mailbox will not be monitored during the holiday period.
