**RE: Return to school**

We are delighted to be able to say that Haverstock will reopen to all pupils from 8 March as announced by the Prime Minister yesterday.

We are currently planning for the safe return of students. This will include the offer of 'Lateral Flow' asymptomatic testing for coronavirus on their return. To ensure that this is done effectively, the return is likely to be staggered across the first few days from 8 March with some students continuing to learn remotely at first. We appreciate that this will be frustrating for them after so long away but it is essential that we maintain a safe environment so that the school can remain open for the longer term. You will receive further information on Tuesday of next week.
